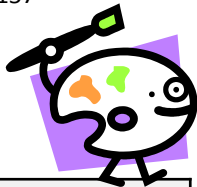

Frank brings a fresh style to MWS this month. His liquid style is unique and distinctive. Frank enjoys working on a very wet surface, letting the pure vibrant color mix itself on the paper. His shapes are large and loose, often disregarding any fine detail. Frank uses abrupt color changes



of the same value with the white of the watercolor paper to bring his paintings to life. His subject matter for watercolors is always varied, reflecting his national and international travels, as well as local western Colorado scenes. Don't miss the demo Sunday Oct 13.

Pauline Goldsmith Appointed to National Artists' Organization Board

Miami, FL --August 13, 2013--Coconut Grove artist **Pauline Goldsmith** has been appointed to the board of directors of the **American Society of Botanical Artists (ASBA)**, based in New York City. Her multi-year term begins in September 2013 at ASBA's annual conference in Pittsburgh.

The organization, whose members hail from around the world, will hold its **2015** conference in **Miami**. www.ASBA-art.org Goldsmith, who is a house manager at The Adrienne Arsht Performing Arts Center in Miami, is co-chairman of **Tropical Botanic Artists**, a collective of Miami-based botanical artists, and is active with the **Miami Watercolor Society** and **GroveHouse Artists**. She exhibits her watercolors widely in the South Florida area and is increasingly involved in promoting environmental art.

Originally from the United Kingdom, Goldsmith arrived in the United States 25 years ago and has never looked back, having resided in Philadelphia, Boston and Miami. "When I moved to South Florida, I found my spiritual home in the tropics," says Goldsmith, whose work is in the permanent collections of Florida International University and private collections in the US and UK. Elaine L. Andrews, BFA, has won the National Association of Women Artists Memorial Award for Watercolor. She recently attended the award reception at the 124th Annual Exhibition of NAWA in New York City at the Sylvia Wald and Po Kim Gallery. Aug 27-Sept 28, 2013.

Established in 1889, NAWA is the first established professional women's art organization in the US. NAWA's documented exhibitions are archived within The Smithsonian Institution Archives; The MOMA, the Metropolitan Museum of Art, the Guggenheim

Museum of American Art, the Ryerson and Burnham Libraries at the Art Institute of Chicago, the Library of Congress, the National Museum of Women in the Arts, the Frick Art Reference Library and the New York Public Library.
