## Taxes — Is your art a hobby or a business?

*The following information should not be considered legal or tax advice. Consult with a tax specialist for your specific situation.*

Is your art a hobby or a business? Regardless of your answer, both have tax implications. The IRS says that you must report any income you get from a hobby or business on your tax return. How you report the income from a hobby is different than how you report income from a business e.g., which tax forms are used. Further, there are special rules and limits for deductions you can claim for a hobby. As a general rule, you can only deduct your hobby expenses up to the amount of your hobby income. If your expenses are more than your income, you have a loss from the activity. You can't deduct that loss from your other income.

Deducting hobby expenses on your tax form is a red flag for IRS because this is an area that is abused by those wanting the government to subsidize a past time activity in which the individual has not shown any organized effort to actually make money. The clear intention is tax avoidance. The IRS uses the following factors to establish that an activity is a business engaged in making a profit:

- Whether you carry on the activity in a businesslike manner.
- Whether the time and effort you put into the activity indicate you intend to make it profitable.
- Whether you depend on income from the activity for your livelihood.
- Whether your losses are due to circumstances beyond your control (or are normal in the startup phase of your type of business).
- Whether you change your methods of operation in an attempt to improve profitability.
- Whether you or your advisors have the knowledge needed to carry on the activity as a successful business.
- Whether you were successful in making a profit in similar activities in the past.
- Whether the activity makes a profit in some years and how much profit it makes.

- Whether you can expect to make a future profit from the appreciation of the assets used in the activity.

### Suggestions:

- Discuss this topic with your tax advisor.
- Learn more by searching the web and talking with experts.
- Keep good records.

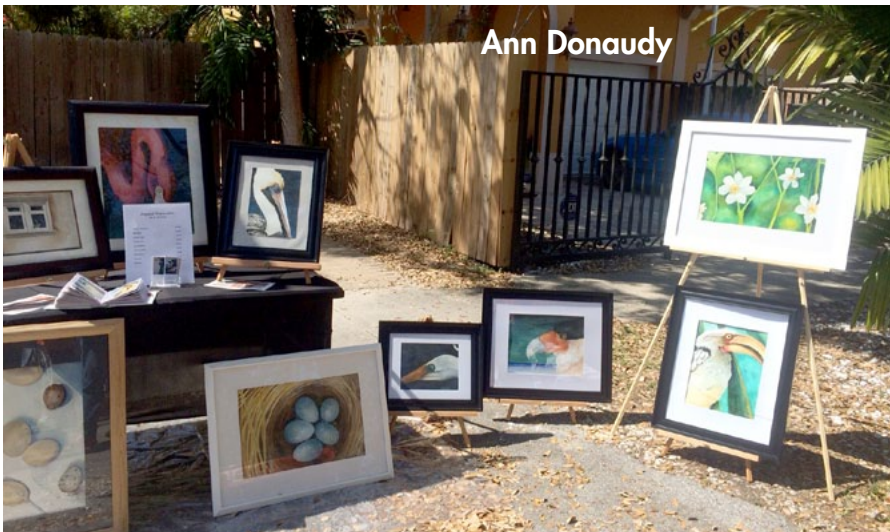
