Teachers Workshop



The MWS's Student/Teacher Outreach committee will produce its annual all-day Miami-Dade County Public School Teachers Workshop at Fairchild Tropical Garden, Saturday, September 9.

It is the first event of the two-part program which will also produce the annual student art show, "Impressions in Watercolor," on November 16, at the Alper JCC.

Up to 32 art teachers will be instructed in a variety of watercolor techniques taught by MWS members including Dottie Greene, who founded the program 32 years ago. Afterward, they will introduce watercolor lesson plans learned at the workshop to their students whose paintings we'll see in the student art show.

Teachers will receive complimentary art materials, breakfast and lunch, and will earn Master Plan Points for their State of Florida re-certification. A huge thank you in advance to those who volunteer their time to be a part of this program.



Coming up in November is an opportunity to be a host at the opening of the "Impressions in Watercolor" student art show.





Artist Statement

My paintings employ a combination of realism and impressionism, with a touch of abstract design. My hope is to evoke the same feeling to the viewer that I felt when first seeing the subject, the sense that there is more to the subject than a mere rendering. Lights, darks, bold colors, lost edges, and more hopefully come together to recreate that feeling. I attempt to apply the illusion of detail in many works so that viewers can use their imagination to complete the image. Sometimes less is more.
